Every dealer on the bourse and behind a table must be a member of the GNA and be in possession of a dealer badge. Annual GNA membership dues are \$15, billed in November. **Table rental fees do not include GNA dues.** Single table rental includes 2 badges, corner table rental includes 3 badges. Add up to 2 per configuration for \$25 each if paid before arrival. **Additions made at the show are treated as Early Birds at \$75 each, so get any changes to me before arrival by email or call 706-267-9602.** Including yourself, please list the names that you want dealer badges issued for. **Please print clearly.**

Wizard Coin Supply is our official supplier of cases and lamps for the show. Contact Wayne Herndon via fax at 703-385-0059. The rental form can be found on our web site and a copy will be included in your confirmation packet mailed to you 6 weeks before the 2026 show date. **Dealers are responsible for their own table/case covers, lamps, and cases. If you don't order from Wayne in advance, they may not be available to order at the show.**

The GNA coin show is at the Dalton Trade & Convention Center, Dalton, GA. Dealer move-in begins at 1:00 PM Thursday, April 16, 2026, and ends at 8:00 P.M. Bourse will open to dealers with badges at 8:30 AM April 17-April 19 and close Fri/Sat at 7:00 P.M. and 5:00 P.M. on Sunday. The bourse area will open to the public with guest badges at 10:00 AM Fri-Sun, and close at 6:00 P.M. Fri/Sat, then 3:00 P.M. on Sunday, April 19, 2026. Insurance against loss of material is the responsibility of the dealer. Uniformed police officers will provide security from 12:00 noon, Thursday, April 16 through 5:00 PM Sunday, April 19, 2026. The bourse area must be vacated by all dealers no later than 5:00 PM Sunday, April 19 when security retires. Early Bird badges (\$75) will allow bourse access starting at 3:00 P.M. Thursday April 16, 2026, then all dealer hours for the show, subject to revision.

Dealers must comply with the GNA Code of Ethics (copy available upon request). No dealer may knowingly exhibit or offer for sale any illegal coins, unmarked counterfeits, forgeries, or copies, or other spurious merchandise. Any such infraction of this rule shall be construed as being against the best interests of numismatics and the GNA. Penalties can be immediate ejection of the dealer from the bourse floor and possible suspension and/or subsequent expulsion from the GNA.

Cancellation Policy: (1) Notice of cancellation must be in writing. (2) Full table payment is due by January 15, 2026. Any reserved tables **not paid in full** by January 15, 2026, will be subject to reassignment at the sole discretion of the GNA. (3) For notices of cancellation received prior to the payment due date, 100% of any payment made will be refunded. (4) For cancellations received 30-90 days prior to show, 75% refunded. (5) Inside of 30 days there are no refunds. (6) The GNA reserves the right to reassign table numbers at its discretion. (7) Dealers are expected to check-in at registration no later than 10:00 A.M. on Friday and occupy their tables until the close of the show on Sunday @ 3:00. Requests for late check-in or early departure will be honored at the discretion of the GNA. Dealers not checked in by 10:00 A.M. on Friday may have their table(s) resold at the sole discretion of the GNA with no recourse to the original dealer. (8) Our special circumstances "roll-over" reservation option is for **free** table space at your usual location the following year and is not eligible for future refund when implemented. Your table must be paid in full to roll-over the reservation. The roll-over option can't be used for consecutive years. No assigned table(s) can be sublet.
